
Why is it important?

- 1. Collect all necessary information from the previous link in the chain
- 2. Map your indirect suppliers and ask them to do the same
- 3. Create a system in which you keep record of the following topics:
- a. Type of product
- b. Country of production
- c. Global Location Number (GLN)
- d. Company name
- e. Process description
- f. Track and trace system
