

500^e MPS-GAP certificate awarded to Griffioen

Perennial plant nursery Griffioen Wassenaar is the 500th company to receive its MPS-GAP certificate. Director Bert Griffioen and crop manager Arie Ravensbergen received the certificate on 21 September from Yolande van den Boom, CEO of the MPS Group.

Sustainability is of paramount importance at Griffioen Wassenaar. Bert Griffioen: “We have been MPS-A certified for years and now we also have MPS-GAP. Griffioen’s perennials are grown sustainably in low-peat substrates. The pots are reused and natural fertilisers are used as much as possible.”
