Five steps to FSI compliancy

1

Are you eligible?

FSI determines whether you can start with MPS-Compact. You can begin your application by clicking the request button on our website.

2

Start keeping records

Once you have requested a quotation, you will be given access to the online record-keeping environment. Then log your usage data for six months (you can also do this retroactively if you are already keeping records).

3

Audit

After six months of record-keeping and meeting the GAP requirements, you will be contacted to schedule the initial audit.

4

Certification

If you pass the audit, you will receive your MPS-Compact certificate.

5

A+, A, B or C qualification

After a total of thirteen record-keeping periods you will receive a qualification, with A+ being the highest achievable.

MPS-Compact is a simple solution for small-scale growers. With an MPS-Compact certification, they meet key market standards and strengthen their position.
